Ralph Crockett Coach and Athletic Director 1962-1984

Ralph served as the school's first athletic director from 1962-1972. He held the position as Head Basketball Coach throughout his 22 year career at Tucker. Coach Crockett recorded 232 wins in 22 years. His Basketball teams won District Titles in 1964,65,73,74 & 76. He also coached the Boys Cross Country Team to the State Title in 1964.

Mark Meleski Baseball 1974-1978

Mark started for two years on the Tiger Varsity Baseball Team. He left Tucker with a batting average of .397 with 64 runs, 28 rbi's and 4 home runs. Mark was All-Metro for two years and selected All-State while at Tucker. He attended the University of Virginia on a full scholarship.

Martha Sainz Basketball 1985-1989

Martha was a four year starter for the Tigers Basketball Team. She is the school's scoring and assist leader. Martha holds the Colonial District Record for most 3 point goals in a game with 7. Martha played basketball at Virginia Wesleyan College.

Kevin Wood Basketball 1970-1974

Kevin was the leading scorer, rebounder, best free throw shooter and best defensive player during his senior year at Tucker. He was the leading scorer in the District as well as All-District, All-Regional and All-Metro.
